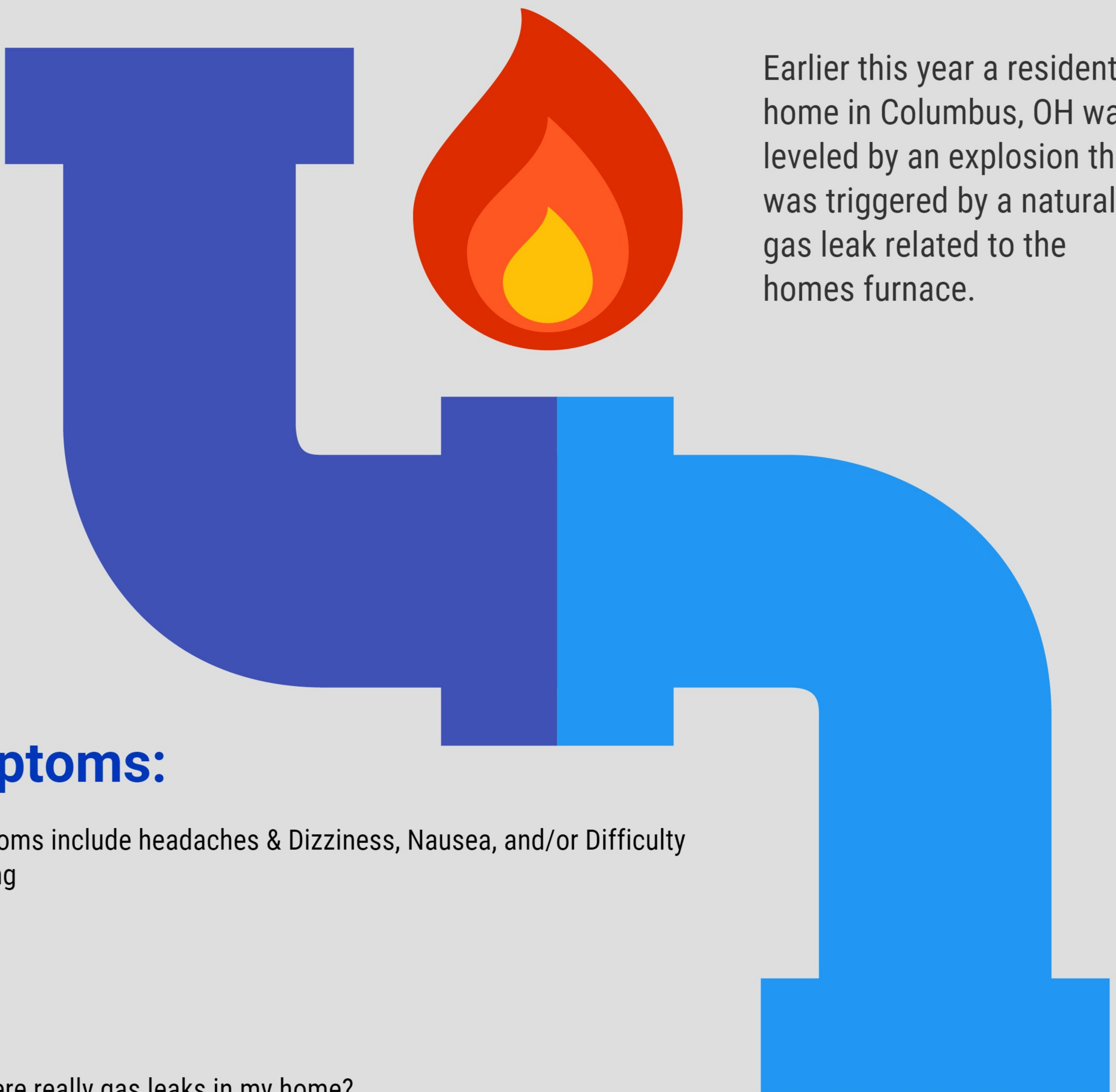




Gas Leaks: Everything You Need To Know To Keep Your Family Safe
