Date: Saturday, September 22 Rain or Shine!

**Location**: Glendale Farm Open Space, located at I-25 on the frontage road between Exit 192 (Ridgegate Pkwy) and Exit 188 (Castle Pines Pkwy). For GPS navigation, the address is 12300 S. Havana Street, Castle Rock, CO 80108.

## Schedule:

Booth set-up – 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. Hike begins – 8:00 a.m. Booth breakdown – Noon (Please plan to occupy your booth until Noon)

**Directions for Park Entry**: Take Exit 188 and head north on frontage road (Havana St.) on the east side of I-25 or take Exit 192 and head south on the frontage road (Havana St.) on the east side of I-25. Once you arrive at Glendale Farm Open Space, drive down to the main parking lot. Let the parking attendant know that you are a sponsor and need to unload your products or materials. Please be sure to check in at the Volunteer/Sponsor/Vendor Check-in booth.

**Location of Your Booth Space**: You will be directed to your booth space, which will be labeled with your company's name. A map and a drive-on pass will be emailed to you the week of the event.

Please unload your items promptly at your booth and then park your car. <u>All vehicles need to be out of the park by 7:30 a.m.</u>

Event volunteers in lime green T-shirts will be available to help set up your canopy, table and chairs. If you need further assistance, please ask any staff member in an orange T-shirt.
